

NCKU Commitment on Social Responsible Investment

In response to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 7(Affordable and Clean Energy) and 13(Climate Action), we established a sustainable investment policy in March 2021, which incorporated environmental, social, and governance (ESG) factors into Endowment Fund investment analysis and decision-making. To fulfill our university social responsibility, we also revised the “NCKU Directions for Endowment Fund Investment” to explicitly include targets that meet the policy as regulated investment items in June 2022.

By the end of 2023, NCKU Endowment Fund has invested in 15 domestic and foreign companies and funds that meet sustainable investment criteria, with a total amount of 592 million NT dollars. The sustainable investment ratio is approximately 92.2%. To implement Principles for Responsible Investment (PRI), we will continue to invest in companies and funds which is committed in terms of ESG practices in the future. We hope to use the power of the capital market to urge companies to strengthen corporate governance and fulfill their social responsibilities.
