



NCKU's Declaration to Climate Change

We are convinced that climate change represents the most significant challenge confronting the world today, playing a crucial role in shaping humanity's future. Our commitment lies in the pursuit of sustainable development goals and the achievement of net-zero emissions by 2050—aims that demand a united effort from all of humanity to forge a sustainable living future. In light of the Sixth Assessment Report by the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC), which underscores the severity of the current climate crisis, National Cheng Kung University (NCKU) hereby issues the following declaration:

Carbon Reduction and Adaptation

1. We will strive to achieve the goal of net-zero emissions by 2050 within our own field, actively participating in global carbon reduction efforts, and dedicating ourselves to creating a more sustainable future.
2. We will continue to advance climate adaptation measures, enhancing the resilience of society and ecosystems, and taking more proactive actions to address climate change.
3. We will vigorously promote energy transition, accelerate the development and application of renewable and clean energy, and gradually phase out fossil fuels to achieve sustainable development goals.
4. We will actively adopt low-carbon, circular economy, and green technologies to promote the development of green industries and sustainable urban construction, thereby achieving energy transition and implementing climate governance.

Sustainable Development Goals

1. We are committed to the implementation of the global Sustainable Development Goals, striving for the sustainable development of the economy, society, and environment.
2. We will actively participate in the Global Stocktake initiative to assess the progress made since the implementation of the 《Paris Agreement》, ensuring that we achieve our sustainable development goals.
3. We will actively advance domestic and international cooperation on climate change, assisting in driving forward the global climate governance process, and collectively addressing the challenges of global climate change.

Sustainable Consumption and Production

1. We will promote sustainable production practices, ensuring product recycling and minimizing waste and resource inefficiency, thereby fostering environmental sustainability and biodiversity conservation.
2. We will advocate for nature-based solutions, striving to achieve a green, climate-resilient, and environmentally friendly ecological economic model, ensuring the sustainable development of ecosystems.



Sustainable Living

1. We will promote a sustainable lifestyle, encouraging all faculty and students to adopt low-carbon, low-pollution, and low-waste living habits, thereby reducing our environmental impact and leading the school towards a more sustainable future.
2. We will actively advocate for circular economy models in various fields such as food, clothing, housing, transportation, education, and entertainment, aiming to achieve effective utilization and reuse of resources.
3. We will enhance education and practical initiatives related to sustainable living and consumption, promote green products and services, and guide all faculty and students to choose more environmentally friendly and low-carbon products and services.

The Climate Change Response Act

1. We will commit to the implementation of the 《Climate Change Response Act》 and take various actions, including emission reduction and adaptation measures, to address the impacts of climate change on Taiwan.
2. We invite local governments and community groups to join us in achieving net-zero goals and striving for global sustainable development. We believe that only through collective efforts can we fulfill these commitments and create a more sustainable future.
